Road Safety Education – Stop! Look! Listen! Think!

In Week 8, students walked around town to observe all the road safety signs and discuss their implications...

- Only walk across school crossing areas after the school bus has left
- Don't cross the street while distracted (no texting or headphones)
- Look left-right-left before crossing
- Drivers must obey the school zone speed limit of 40km/h during the times on the school zone signs
- Always wear a helmet when you ride, scooter or skate
- Always buckle up your seatbelt
- Always hold an adult's hand when you cross the road, up to 10 years old
- Get in and out of the car on the footpath side

Road trains, buses, caravans and farm vehicles are common along Boomi streets so please take care!









CPR and Snake Bite First Aid Course

We had an early recess yesterday then travelled to Garah PS to hear Cameron from NSW CPR Program deliver a very hands-on course in first aid. He demonstrated how to perform cardio-pulmonary resuscitation on adults, children and babies then we had a go on different mannequins- 30 compressions in the centre of the chest then 2 breaths. Cameron then showed us how to apply a pressure bandage after a snake bite. You never know who, when or where sudden illness or injury will strike and you're never too young to start learning first-aid.
